There will be YOUTH fun sessions on -

### **Hi-Point Youth**

Exhibitors must sign-up for hi-point awards at the show office prior to the start of the show on Sat, May 15. Points will be calculated from combined points of all four Judges.

Points will be awarded as follows:

1st = 6 points, 2nd = 5 points, 3rd = 4 points, 4th = 3 points, 5th = 2 points, 6th = 1 point.

If there are 6 or more horses in a class. If there are less than 6 horses in a class, points will be based on the number of horses entered. Awards will be given for one youth/horse combination. Points will be from youth classes only.

### **Hi-Point Amateur**

Award will be given to the amateur/horse combination that receives the highest number of points in Amateur classes.

AOTE classes do not count.

### **Stalls**

Stalls are box stalls 10 X 10. Stalls will be available at Noon, Thursday, April 28 and must be vacated by Sunday, May 1 at 9 pm. Anyone wanting to stay longer must make arrangements with the show management and additional fees will apply. No bedding is included with stalls. Shavings will be available on the show grounds for \$8.50/bag. Please order your shavings on the entry form. NO SHAVINGS MAY BE BROUGHT ONTO THE SHOW GROUNDS.

The State of Texas Animal Health regulations for all horses are as follows: each horse must have a health certificate current within 30 days and a Negative coggins (EIA) test within 12 months.

## Refund Policy

The CTMHC will give a full refund, other than stalls, if entries are cancelled in writing by the closing date of the horse show. If entries are canceled in writing and accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate of inability to show, after the closing date, but before the official start of the show - 8:30 am April 30, 2011, all fees other than stall and office fee will be refunded. After the official start of the show, there will be no refunds.
