Arrival Time: No Arrivals Before noon on 6/15 Without Prior Notification

All participating horses must be AMHA registered. Stallions three years and older must have a stallion certificate to participate. All horses must be measured. Stalls are \$80.00 for Thursday - Sunday (two horse maximum) or \$30.00 for Sunday only. Showing out of the trailer will also be \$30.00 for up to two horses for Sunday. A grounds fee of \$5.00 per horse will be charged. Camper hook-ups are \$45.00 per day for electric and water; \$50.00 for full hookup with sewer. Valid AMHA registration, youth and/or amateur numbers, and current coggins (within 1 year), and health certificate within 30 days on out of state horses must be provided. Foals six months and younger do not require a coggins. **Make checks payable to: Orange Blossom Miniature Horse Club. General Rules and Information:

This show is accredited and conducted under the 2022 rules and regulations of the American Miniature Horse Association. All horses must be registered with the American Miniature Horse Association. This show has three judges. Points and awards will be awarded by each judge. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 6th place. Championship Ribbons will be awarded for Grand Champions, Reserve Grand Champions & Supremes.

General Rules and Information

Entry Fees: **Open Classes:** \$35.00; OBMHC Members \$30.00
Amateur and Adult Special Needs Classes: \$30.00; OBMHC Members \$25.00
Youth Classes: \$25.00; OBMHC Members \$20.00
Pre-entry deadline: May 30, 2022

Youth Classes: All youth must have an AMHA Youth number to participate. An application may be filled out at the Horse Show Office day of show if needed. **AMHA youth are those youth 18 years & under as of January 1, 2023.**

Amateur Classes: An AMHA Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Amateur cards are \$15.00 to AMHA members if purchased at the show; \$50.00 to non-members. Applications are available at the Horse Show Office. Amateurs showing in Amateur/AOTE classes must be the owner of the horse or an immediate family member. **AOTE horses must not have been handled by a professional handler under any circumstance since December 31, 2022.**

Measuring: Measuring will begin at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 15th through 8:00 p.m. and each morning thereafter from 7:00 – 8:00 a.m. each day or at a scheduled time as requested in the show office. All horses must be measured. Exhibitor packets and numbers will be issued after measurement. Hardship measuring for AMHA will be done at the scheduled times or by appointment with notification of such measurement posted at the show office.

Office Information: Please have a copy of your horse's coggins (within 1 year) available, 30 day health certificate on out-of-State horses, & copy of registration showing both sides. Owners of senior stallions (3 yrs. & older) must present a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection for cryptorchidism to show management prior to participating in an AMHA approved show. Judges Evaluation Cards will be available in the Show Office, and may be completed on a voluntary basis. Gelding status must be reflected on the papers, or a show letter.

Entries: All entry forms, copies of both sides of the AMHA registration papers for each horse, copy of Amateur and/or Youth cards, and a check/money order in payment of classes, stalls, RV fees, etc., are to be sent to Show Manager Tracey Slagle. Checks are to be made payable to Orange Blossom Miniature Horse Club. PayPal is also accepted via friends and family or appropriate fees included. Coggins and health papers may be presented at check in. Entries postmarked after the pre-entry deadline will be assessed a post-entry fee of \$5.00 per class.

Refunds: There will be no refunds given on any entries or fees.

PA System: **It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to the barn area are a management courtesy. Tack holds need to be requested with the gateperson.**

Gate Rule: **The two-minute gate rule will be in effect for ALL shows. The two-minute timing shall start when the last horse enters the ring.**

Gate Check-In Policy: **The exhibitor is responsible to get oneself into the class. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to check-in with the gate person and make sure you're on the class sheet. No late entries shall be allowed entry into the ring, even if you have already checked in for your class. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

Conduct: Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls or on the fairgrounds is strictly prohibited. The use of stimulants or depressants or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden.

Special Needs Exhibitors: Special needs exhibitors are welcome to show. We would appreciate advance notice if any special arrangements need to be made. Please contact the show manager.

Stabling: Box stalls available for \$90 for Thursday-Sunday (maximum of 2 horses per stall) or \$30.00 for Sunday only. Shavings available for \$8.50 per bag. Use of straw as bedding is prohibited. Stall cleanings to be dumped in designated areas only. Showing off the trailer is permitted at \$30.00 for up to 2 horses for Sunday only. **Horses MAY NOT BE LEFT TIED FOR AN EXTENDED TIME BY THE ARENA.**

Smoking: No smoking will be allowed in the barns, on deck, in the arena or in the horse show office.
