All participating horses must be ASPC or AMHR or ASPR registered. All horses must be measured or present a valid measurement card (within 60 days or annual). Stalls are \$90.00 for Thursday - Sunday (two horse maximum). Showing out of the trailer will also be \$80.00 for weekend (two horse max) & \$30.00 for Sunday (two horse max). A grounds fee of \$5.00 per horse will be charged. Camper hook-ups are \$45.00 per day for electric and water; \$50.00 for full hookup with sewer. Valid ASPC/AMHR registration, youth and/or amateur numbers, and current coggins (within 1 year), and health certificate within 30 days on out of state horses must be provided. Foals six months and younger do not require a coggins. **Make checks payable to: Orange Blossom Miniature Horse Club. General Rules and Information:

This show is accredited and conducted under the 2023 rules and regulations of the American Shetland Pony Club/American Miniature Horse Registry.

All horses must be registered with the ASPC/AMHR.

This show has three judges. Points and awards will be awarded by 3 judges for AMHR & Classics, Moderns & ASPR.

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 6th place. Championship Ribbons will be awarded for Champions, Reserve Champions, Grand Champions, Reserve Grand Champions & Champion of Champions.

General Rules and Information

Entry Fees: **Open Classes:** \$35.00 Non Member
 Amateur and Adult Special Needs Classes: \$30.00 Non Member
 Youth Classes: \$25.00 Non Member
 Flat Fee: \$125.00 OBMHC Members Only - Per Horse/10 Class Limit
 Pre-entry deadline: **May 30, 2022**
 Late Entry Fee: \$5.00 per class in addition to regular class fees.

Youth Classes: Youth may show without a membership, but all youth must have an ASPC/AMHR Youth number to be eligible for any ASPC/AMHR/ASPR Youth Awards. An application may be filled out with the ASPC/AMHR Steward. Youth membership is free.

Non Rated Classes: These classes will be open to any horse 38" & Under. The 1st and 2nd of each of the Non Rated Adult and Non Rated Youth classes will come back in for the Non Rated Grand & Reserve Champion class. The Non Rated Grand Champion will be included in the Champion of Champions Class. These classes will only have one judge and are \$10 per class

Amateur Classes: An ASPC/AMHR Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Amateur cards are \$20.00 if applied for at the show. Exhibitors must be a member of ASPC/AMHR to apply. Applications are available from the show steward.

Measuring: Measuring will begin at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 15th through 8:00 p.m. and each morning thereafter beginning at 7:00 a.m. each day or make arrangements with the steward. All horses must be measured or present a valid measurement card. Exhibitor packets and numbers will be issued after measurement. A clear copy of your registration papers must be presented at measuring.

Office Information: Please have a copy of your horse's coggins (within 1 year) available, 30 day health certificate on out-of-State horses, & copy of registration showing both sides. Judges and Show Evaluation forms will be available in the Show Office and may be completed on a voluntary basis.

Entries: All entry forms, copies of both sides of the ASPC/AMHR/ASPR registration papers for each horse, copy of Amateur and/or Youth cards, and a check/money order in payment of classes, stalls, RV fees, etc., are to be sent to Show Manager Tracey Slagle. Checks are to be made payable to Orange Blossom Miniature Horse Club. Credit Card (4% fee) and PayPal are also accepted Coggins and health papers may be presented at check in. Entries postmarked after the pre-entry deadline will be assessed a post-entry fee of \$5.00 per class.

Refunds: There will be no refunds given on any entries or fees.

PA System: **It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to the barn area are a management courtesy. Tack holds need to be requested with the gateperson.**

Gate Rule: **The two-minute gate rule will be in effect for ALL shows. The two-minute timing shall start when the last horse enters the ring.**

Gate Check-In Policy: **The exhibitor is responsible to get oneself into the class. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to check-in with the gate person and make sure you're on the class sheet. No late entries shall be allowed entry into the ring, even if you have already checked in for your class. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

Conduct: Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls or on the fairgrounds is strictly prohibited. The use of stimulants or depressants or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden.

Special Needs Exhibitors: Special needs exhibitors are welcome to show. We would appreciate advance notice if any special arrangements need to be made. Please contact the show manager.

Stabling: Box stalls available for \$90 for Thurs-Sun (maximum of 2 horses per stall). Arrivals before 5:00 a.m. Thursday will be charged \$15.00 per occupied stall. Shavings available for \$8.50 per bag. Use of straw as bedding is prohibited. Stall cleanings to be dumped in designated areas only. Showing off the trailer is permitted at \$80.00 for the weekend (two horse max) & \$30.00 for Sunday (two horse max). **Horses MAY NOT BE LEFT TIED FOR AN EXTENDED TIME BY THE ARENA.**

Smoking: No smoking will be allowed in the barns, on deck, in the arena or in the horse show office.
