Directions to Spanaway, WA

From I-5: Exit on; Hwy 512 (Puyallup, Mt. Rainier) and go east for 2.1 miles to the Pacific Avenue Exit. Go South (right turn at light) for 4.5 miles and turn left on 176th Street South—head east for 1.1 miles. The Tacoma Unit will be on the right-turn down 14th Ave. E for entrance to the Unit.

From Auburn & Puyallup: Coming from Auburn take Hwy 167 South—take Hwy 512 West Exit (just past Sumner)-from Puyallup just take Hwy 512 West. Take the Canyon Road/Summit exit and go left (South) on Canyon Road E about 5 miles. Turn right on 176th Street E. & go West for 2.6 miles—the Tacoma Unit will be on the left side—turn left on 14th Ave. E for entrance to the Unit.

Condition of Entry: Every entry will be under the jurisdiction of the Evergreen Miniature Horse Club (EMHC) show management, but the EMHC will in no case be responsible for any loss of damage that may occur.

It shall be a condition of the entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show Evergreen Spectacular show management, EMHC, ASPC/AMHR, and or the Tacoma Unit #1 & employees harmless for any loss of injury to their horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, accident or any other factor.

Show Rules, Requirements, and Information

This show is open to all AMHR Registered Miniature Horses and all ASPC, ASPR, NSPPR, Registered Shetlands/Ponies. The show is accredited by the ASPC/AMHR and will be conducted under ASPC/AMHR Official Show Rules. A copy of the official rule book may be found in the show office.

Youth Requirements: It is required that all youth exhibitors must wear protective headgear (Certified ASTM/SEI) in Roadster and Under Saddle Classes. Headgear harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (Certified ASTM/SEI) in any division or class without penalty from the judge.

Amateur Status: Important requirements to this show: Copies of current year Amateur cards must be included with your entries. Amateur class entries will not be processed without a current Amateur Card include in your entries. Any person entering an Amateur class must show prove of Amateur status with a current 2025 Amateur number and current 2025 ASPC Membership. A copy of your Membership and Amateur Card must be included in your entries or presented at the show. If you do not show proof of membership/amateur status you will not be allowed to participate in any Amateur classes. An Amateur Card can be purchased day of show. In order to purchase an Amateur Card you must be a current member of ASPC/AMHR. Proof of Membership must be presented in order to obtain an Amateur card. If you are not able to provide proof of current membership, you will need to purchase both an ASPC/AMHR Membership and Amateur Card in order to participate in Amateur classes with your points earned going towards the National ASPC/AMHR/ASPR Amateur Program.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Copies of current horse's registrations papers. Current 2025 Amateur and/or Youth Card. Current Youth Card and entry fee check must be submitted with entries. Entries must be on the official entry form for this show. Entry forms may be photocopied for use. All requested information must be provided for each horse entered. Forms will not be accepted unless they are complete and accompanied by required fees and a copy of AMHR/ASPC registration papers for all horses entered. Numbers will not be released without full payment of all fees. Entries are responsible for the accuracy of entry forms prepared by themselves or their agents. Gelding status must be shown on registration forms, and all foals of the current year must be registered prior to the show. Entries received after the closing date will not be listed in the Show Program due to print time needed. There will be a \$50.00 charge for all checks returned for lack of funds.

Measuring:

All horses shall be measured in accordance with AMHR/ASPC rules. If your horse has a current year measurement card, or has been measured within the last 60 days, please submit a copy of the card with your entry. All horses will be measured by the Show Steward with an official certified AMHR/ASPC measuring stick. All horses measured at the show will be measured with the same stick. Registration papers and other necessary paperwork MUST be presented to the Show Steward for each animal entered at the time of measurement.

Measuring and Show Hours: Measuring Times:

Thursday 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm Friday/Saturday 7:00 am to 7:45 am, and by appointments Sunday By appointment only

If needing measured, please have any blanket or neck wraps off the horse and have all the paperwork required for measuring in hand. Otherwise you will be sent to the back of the line. Our shows start promptly at 8:00am on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, unless otherwise notified. Lunch and dinner breaks, & warm up times will be announced as warranted throughout the show weekend.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Check your state requirements if you are traveling from out of state.

Office Check In: Check in will begin approx. at 3:00 PM on Thursday. Each horse will need to be measured unless you are in possession of a current ASPC/AMHR measurement card that has already had its yearly height verification, or a current 60 day temporary card.

GATE RULE:

It is the goal of the management that this show present AMHR/ASPC horses in the best light possible, be entertaining to those who have come to watch the event and expediently move through the class schedule for exhibitors. EACH EXHIBITOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR MONITORING THE PROGRESS OF CLASSES AND BEING PREPARED TO ENTER THE RING PROMPTLY WHEN A CLASS HAS BEEN CALLED - WITHOUT PRIOR PUBLIC NOTICE. The gate will remain open for two (2) minutes after each class has been called to enter the ring. Horses not in the arena when the gate is closed will be eliminated from the class and entry fee will not be refunded. Breaks have been incorporated into the show schedule for necessary tack changes and to set up equipment. Additional gate holds not to exceed two (2) minutes requested by exhibitors, may be called at the discretion of the show manager. ALL GATE HOLDS MUST BE REQUESTED FROM THE SHOW OFFICE AT LEAST FOUR CLASSES IN ADVANCE OF THE REQUESTED HOLD.

County Code Requirements:

PIERCE COUNTY CODE REQUIREMENTS
NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES in buildings, barns or arena
NO PARKING w/in 30 ft. of barns--NO ELECTRICAL CORD from barns to RV's

- 1. Abuse to animals, show personnel or other exhibitors will not be tolerated & will result in disqualification & exhibitor expulsion from the show
- 2. Horses may not be kept in trailers overnight.
- 3. Horses may not be left unattended unless stalled.
- 4. Dogs must be on a leash at all times--no pets in arena or barn aisles.

SHAVINGS DISPOSAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Used shavings and manure must be disposed of at the end of each barn in the manure bunkers. Dumping in areas not maked DUMP ZONE will be charged a clean up fee. Stalls with nails left in them will be an extra day fee. Any stall that has water buckets dumped in it wil be charged a \$50 clean up fee. Portable corrals or overnight tying or staking of horses is not allowed. Horses must be in facility stalls. Special arrangements may be made by the show for exhibitors needing to arrive prior to the day before the show. (This is not guaranteed and will be an additional Horse Hotel charge.) NOTE! End of Use/Show Stall Cleaning Fee PAID Courtesy of EMHC Sponsors! Please check our website and/or Facebook page prior to Closing Date as we are negotiating shavings to be able to be preordered with your entry to be at the facility, if desired. Market pricing will apply.

LUNCH & DINNER BREAKS:

No specified lunch break has been scheduled. Show management and judges will determine the progress of classes and announce a lunch break to occur as close to 12:00 Noon as possible. Classes will run according to the schedule unless stated otherwise in the class list. A dinner break will be called if necessary.

POST ENTRIES - ADDING CLASSES:

After the closing date for entries of June 26, 2025, a flat post entry fee of \$20 may be assessed. Additional classes for horses entered by June 26 may be added without additional cost. Post entries or added classes will be accepted up to five classes prior to the class entering the ring - provided the horse is determined to be eligible for entry. Post entries made for the first five classes each day will be accepted up to one-half (1/2) hour prior to the first class entering the ring. Post entries made during the show must be made at the show office and will not be accepted unless accompanied by full payment. Management reserves the right to accept entries for unfilled classes after the closing date at the regular entry fee. This must be paid before entry numbers will be issued at this or any following show.

SCRATCHED CLASSES - REFUNDS:

No entry fees will be refunded without a Veterinarian's Certificate as to the unsoundness of the entered horse. This must be presented to the show secretary before the first class of the day. Failure to show a horse that has been entered constitutes a forfeiture of entry fees. In the event of the sudden illness of a horse after the entry deadline, exhibitor may substitute another animal at no additional charge. If done at the show, it must be done within the time frame outlined in the Post Entry section. Refunds will be mailed to exhibitors after the conclusion of the show.

STABLING:

Stalls occupied by horses will be available for the weekend for \$125.00, and stalls not occupied by horses for \$115.00 (ie: feed, tack, dressing room), which begins at noon Thursday July 11, 2025 and ends after the last class on Sunday July 13, 2025. Exhibitors needing stalls, who wish to arrive earlier or stay beyond Sunday evening, must contact the Show Manager before arriving. The charge for additional days is \$40.00 per stall per day used. If you wish you may bring your own shavings. There will be no refunds on stalls. Stalls must be paid for at the time reservation is made. Note: The entry form contains a space to enter the person you wish to be stalled near. Every effort will be made to meet your request. Trailer stalling is not allowed.
